<b>Indiana Blush</b>	Similar to White Zin. Made from our own grapes. This wine will go with any meal.	\$8.95
<b>Indiana White</b>	Fermented entirely from Vignoles from our own vineyard. Peach & nectarine aromas and flavors.	\$8.95
<b>Indiana Red</b>	Light & fruity red wine perfect for picnics. Made with grapes from our vineyard. Medal winner at the 2001 Indiana State Fair.	\$8.95
